Your New Jersey State Health Benefits Program now includes the option for you and your family to get personalized, convenient primary care with no co-pays by joining an R-Health primary care practice. Typically, there is a monthly membership to join an R-Health practice. However, the New Jersey State Health Benefits Program is covering 100% of the R-Health membership for employees and their dependents. The only caveat is this is not available to employees with an HMO plan, or Medicare retirees.

This is not a change in your insurance plan, simply a primary care doctor selection for enhanced primary care with no-copays or other hidden fees. It works with the current health insurance plans available through the state, including Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Jersey and Aetna.

R-Health has offices in Ewing, Haddonfield, and Moorestown, NJ and Washington Crossing, PA. It has plans to add multiple convenient new locations throughout Central and Southern NJ in 2017. You can sign up for R-Health at www.r-health.md/nj or call 800.797.1289.

Some of the main benefits of R-Health Direct Primary Care include:

- Zero membership fees
- Same-day and next-day appointments
- Evening and weekend hours
- Cell phone, e-mail, and digital access to your doctor
- Little to no time in the waiting room
- Onsite lab draws
- Doctors can prescribe and dispense onsite a 7-day supply of basic medications for acute conditions
- Immunizations included in membership and given onsite
