Social Security Trends and Your Retirement

Christopher J. Carrozza, CPA, ChFC is our VALIC Financial Planning Advisor and he will be on campus to present a seminar titled “Social Security Trends and Planning Your Retirement” on Wednesday, May 24, 2017. The seminar will be held in the Viewing Room of the Campus Center from 10:00am-11:30am. You are not required to have investments with VALIC in order to attend; it is open to all employees. The seminar will address when to begin your Social Security benefits to maximize your lifetime retirement income; how to capitalize on benefits you may be entitled to based on your spouse’s earnings; understand the potential impact continuing to work has on your ability to collect Social Security benefits while still working; benefits for divorced spouses, survivor income; planning for tax consequences of Social Security benefits; filing and suspending benefits; and building an income bridge to enable you to delay receipt of Social Security benefits.
